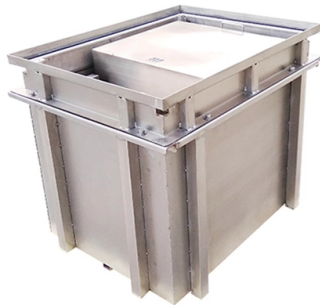


Requirements for Level 1 Electrical Distribution Boxes on Construction Sites

Level 1 electrical distribution boxes on construction sites must comply with OSHA and NEC standards, ensuring proper enclosure, grounding, protection, and safe access for temporary power use. Unused openings in boxes or fittings must be effectively closed to prevent accidental contact. Conductors entering boxes must be protected from abrasion, and bushings or smooth surfaces should be used where cords pass through openings. For systems over 600 volts, fencing, barriers, or other means must prevent access by unauthorized personnel. Grounding and Continuity Metal raceways, cable armor, and enclosures must be metallically joined to provide continuous electrical continuity and connected to all boxes and fittings. Grounding ensures that any exposed metal parts do not pose a shock hazard. Working Space and Access A minimum of 3 feet (914 mm) of clear working space must be maintained in front of switchboards, panelboards, or motor control centers. Headroom in working spaces must be at least 6 feet 3 inches (1.91 m). At least one entrance must provide access to the working space around the equipment. Working spaces must not be used for storage and should be guarded when live parts are exposed. Safety Features GFCI protection is required for receptacles in damp or wet locations.
