

Requirements for laying optical cables on highways



AI Overview

Highway optical fiber cables should be laid in trenches at a minimum depth of 1.65 meters with protective conduits, proper bedding, and adherence to regulatory and safety standards.

Trenching and Depth Requirements For direct-buried optical fiber cables along highways, the trench depth is typically 1.65 meters, with a bottom width of approximately 250–300 mm to accommodate the cable and protective measures. In areas with underground utilities or obstacles, trenches may need to be deeper, and DWC (double-wall corrugated) pipes are recommended to protect the cables. The trench bottom should be horizontal, free of stones, and tamped at transition points between hard and soft surfaces to prevent cable damage.

Cable Protection and Bedding Cables must be laid on a stable, uniform bedding to avoid stress from uneven surfaces. Protective measures include: DWC pipes or innerducts for direct burial; Tamped fill at transitions from solid to soft surfaces; Additional armor or rodent protection where necessary; Figure-eight coiling for slack management at splice points.

Installation Practices Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) is preferred where feasible to minimize surface disruption. Pulling tension must not exceed the cable's maximum tensile rating (e.g., 2,700 N for stranded loose tube cables). Bend radius should be at least twice the minimum working bend radius to prevent fiber damage. Splice points should be pre-marked and prepared to reduce open trench hazards.

Clearance and Regulatory Standards Minimum 18 feet clearance above traveled roads for aerial installations on poles. Minimum 40 inches clearance from energized conductors or utility lines. Compliance with TEC India guidelines, FOA installation standards, and ITU-T L.163 recommendations ensures proper route planning, cable selection, and risk mitigation during installation and operation.
