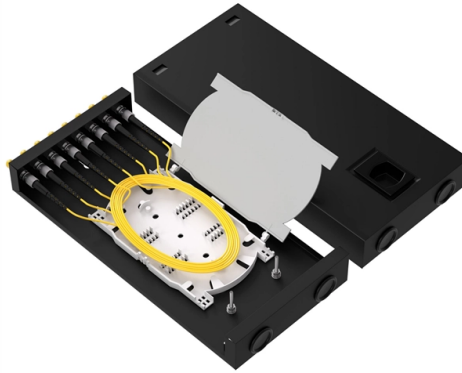

Overview A residential distribution box (DB box), also called a breaker box or electrical panel, is the central hub of a home's electrical system. - Circuit Breakers:** Automatic switches that protect individual circuits from overcurrent. Types include:
 - 1P (Single Pole):** Controls only the live wire.
 - 1P+N (Single Pole + Neutral):** Protects both live and neutral wires.
 - 2P (Double Pole):** Provides full isolation for both live and neutral wires, ideal for high-power appliances.
- Sub-Circuits:** Separate circuits for lighting, room sockets, and high-power appliances like air conditioners or water heaters, ensuring localized protection and preventing system-wide outages.
- Additional Protection Devices:** May include residual current devices (RCDs), overvoltage/undervoltage protectors, and surge protection for enhanced safety.

- Surface Mounted:** Installed on walls, suitable for retrofits or industrial-style setups.
- Flush Mounted:** Embedded into walls for a clean, aesthetic look, common in modern homes.
- Single Phase DB Boxes:** Standard for most residential properties, handling typical household loads.
- Lighting Distribution Boxes:** Dedicated to lighting circuits for uninterrupted illumination.
- Power Distribution Boxes:** Support sockets and heavy appliances, ensuring safe operation of high-power devices.
