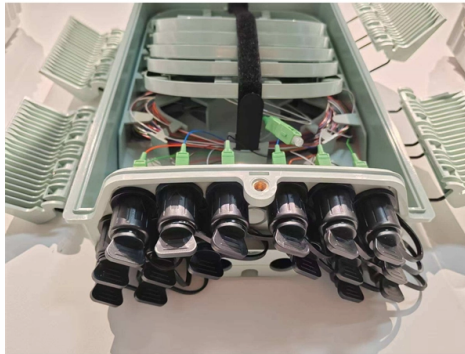


Router Login Fiber Optic Settings

You can access your fiber optic router's settings by connecting to it via a web browser using its IP address, then logging in with the default or provided credentials.

Step 1: Connect Your Router Ensure your fiber modem or ONT (Optical Network Terminal) is powered on and connected to the fiber line from your ISP. Common defaults are 192.168.1.1, 192.168.0.1, or 10.0.0.2. Log in using the default username and password (often both are "admin") or the credentials provided by your ISP.

Step 3: Configure Settings Once logged in, you can access sections such as:

- Wireless Settings:** Change your Wi-Fi network name (SSID) and password, select 2.4 GHz or 5 GHz bands for range or speed.
- LAN Settings:** Adjust IP addresses and subnet masks to fit your network range.
- Security Settings:** Set encryption type (WPA2/WPA3) and strong passwords to protect your network.
- Firmware Updates:** Check for and install updates to ensure optimal performance and security.

Step 4: Save and Test Save any changes and restart the router if prompted. Verify connectivity by connecting a device to the Wi-Fi or Ethernet and running a speed test. If issues arise, reboot both the ONT and router, or contact your ISP for assistance.

Tips for Optimal Performance Place the router in a central, open location to maximize Wi-Fi coverage. Avoid bending or damaging fiber optic cables, as they are fragile. Regularly update passwords and firmware to maintain security and performance. Following these steps will allow you to access and manage your fiber optic router settings efficiently, ensuring a secure and high-speed network.
