Supports should be spaced according to load ratings and material specifications, and trays should be inspected for corrosion or damage. Overhead installations require careful attention to prevent injury from falling components.

Working at Height: Installation and maintenance often occur on ladders, scaffolds, or lifts. Workers should use proper fall protection, handle sharp edges carefully, and follow safe lifting practices to avoid cuts or physical injuries.
