- Steel:** Hot-dip galvanized or powder-coated for corrosion resistance.
- Aluminum:** Lightweight, corrosion-resistant, and suitable for indoor and outdoor environments.
- Stainless Steel:** Used in high-corrosion or cleanroom environments.

Dimensions

- Width:** Nominal inside usable width ranges from small control circuits to large power trunk runs; outside width slightly larger due to side rail thickness.
- Depth (Side Rail Height):** Controls vertical stacking capacity and affects heat dissipation and NEC fill compliance.
- Length:** Standard sections typically 10 feet (3 meters), with modular fittings for bends, tees, and risers.
- Material Thickness:** Selected based on load requirements and span length.

Load Ratings and Support

Load class defines the tray's weight-carrying capacity over a specific support span. Proper selection ensures mechanical support and strain relief for cables. Support spans, rung spacing (6–9 inches for ladder trays), and mounting methods must be considered to prevent sagging and maintain cable integrity.
