Busbars: Copper or aluminum strips, insulated or color-coded for phases, providing central connection points. Neutral and Grounding Links: Ensure proper return paths and safety grounding. Isolators: Allow safe maintenance by disconnecting circuits manually. Cable Glands: Heavy-duty, double-compression type for secure cable entry and exit.
