- Color Coding:** Follow standard color codes for line (live), neutral, and ground wires to ensure proper identification.
- Cable Entry:** Ensure all cable inlets and cover joints are sealed with no visible gaps to maintain safety and prevent dust or moisture ingress.

Circuit Protection and Components Install circuit breakers, fuses, and surge protectors for each branch circuit to prevent overloads, short circuits, and electrical hazards. Consider Residual-Current Devices (RCDs) or RCBOs for additional protection against leakage currents. Use DIN rails for mounting devices and terminal blocks to organize wiring efficiently.

Grounding and Safety The metal enclosure, electrical board, and all metallic components inside the box must be properly grounded. Connect the protective neutral wire reliably through the terminal board. Operators should wear i...
