The NEC also specifies that the working space in front of the panel should be at least 3 feet deep and 30 inches wide, with a minimum height of 6.5 feet (≈ 2 meters) or the height of the equipment, whichever is greater. Additional Considerations Outdoor or ground-mounted boxes should be installed at least 3 feet above the ground to prevent water damage. Clearance and ventilation around the box are essential to prevent overheating and allow safe maintenance.
