

Standard requirements for the dimensions of optical cable pre-buried conduits

Requirements vary based on location, cable type, and local regulations, with depths typically ranging from 18 to 48 inches. Residential areas require depths between 24 and 36. Underground cables are pulled in conduit that is buried underground, usually 1-1.2 meters (3-4 feet) deep to reduce the likelihood of accidentally being dug up. In extreme cold climates, cables may need to be buried at greater depths where there temperatures are colder and frost penetrates to. OPTICAL FIBRE INSTALLATIONS

For Optical Fibre Backbone Cable installations, a minimum 30.0 m of cable must be stored / coiled in C8 pits no greater than 1000 m apart for future installation requirements.

FOA Standard For Installing Fiber Optic Cable Plants

The following language is recommended for use in project documents: Fiber optic cables shall be installed in accordance with the FOA Standard for Installing Fiber Optic Cable Plants.

Conduit Installation A conduit cable installation involves placement of one or more optical cables inside a preinstalled conduit that runs between access points. Access points can be as large as a manhole

If the splice enclosure is direct buried, the excess cable should be stored in vertical positioned loops that meet the minimum bending radius of the cable. This limits damage to the cable if ground settles or
