

Standards for fiber optic cable connection to homes



AI Overview

To connect fiber optic cable to a home, you need a physical fiber line to the property, an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), proper internal wiring, and professional installation.

External Infrastructure A fiber connection begins at a local distribution point, such as a street cabinet or junction box, and runs either underground or overhead to your home (). The installation method depends on neighborhood infrastructure:

Underground Installation: A trench is dug from the street to the house, and the fiber cable is laid within protective conduit. This method is preferred for aesthetics and weather protection ().

Aerial Installation: Fiber cables are strung from utility poles to the home. This is faster but more exposed to environmental damage ().

The fiber cable itself is made of thin glass or plastic strands, bundled and insulated to withstand environmental conditions ().

Internal Equipment At the point where the fiber enters the home, an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) is installed. The ONT converts light signals from the fiber into data your devices can use (). It is typically installed in a convenient, out-of-the-way location such as a closet, garage, or corner of a room. The ONT connects to your home network via an Ethernet cable to a router or gateway ().

Internal Wiring and Protection Fiber cables are delicate and require careful handling:

- Use single-mode fiber for residential FTTH installations ().
- Maintain a minimum bend radius to prevent signal loss, typically ten times the cable diameter or at least 1.5 inches for indoor patch cables ().
- Protect cables in low-voltage conduit when running through walls or high-traffic areas ().
- Secure cables with Velcro straps rather than tight zip ties to avoid crushing the fiber ().
- Use plastic bushings or grommets when drilling through studs or joists to prevent abrasion ().
