

Switch Stacking Fiber Optic Cables

Types of Fiber and Connectors

- Single-Mode Fiber (SMF):** Used for longer distances, often several kilometers.
- Connectors:** LC connectors are standard for SFP modules, while MPO connectors are used for high-density 40G and 100G parallel connections.
- SFP Modules and Compatibility** Switch stacking requires compatible SFP or QSFP transceivers. Cisco Meraki and Catalyst switches support a range of 1/10/25/40/100G SFP/QSFP fiber transceivers. It is important to verify compatibility with the switch model, as using unsupported optics can cause stack instability. Vendor documentation or compatibility matrices should be consulted before deployment.
- Stacking Configurations**
 - Star Topology:** All switches connect to a central switch using fiber, reducing collisions and improving performance.
 - Daisy Chain / Hybrid Stack:** Switches are connected in series using stacking ports or SFP uplinks. Hybrid stacking may be required when mixing different switch models.
- Vendor-Specific Notes**
 - Cisco Catalyst 9300 Series:** Supports StackWise cables (0.5 m, 1 m, 3 m) and optional StackWise-320 kits for certain models. MPO connectors are used for 40G/100G stacking.
 - Extreme Networks Switches:** Only verified stacking cables and compatible fiber optics should be used to avoid stack instability. Alterna...
