

Tanzanian Standard Optical Cable

Tanzania has established technical standards and regulatory rules for optical fiber cables to ensure quality, safety, and interoperability in telecommunications networks.

Technical Standards The Tanzania Bureau of Standards (TBS) specifies requirements for optical fiber cables (OFC) covering operational wavelengths, attenuation, chromatic dispersion, and polarization mode dispersion. Cables must be properly marked and labeled at all manholes, entry, and end points to ensure traceability and compliance. Outdoor and aerial cables follow family specifications for self-supporting telecommunication cables, aligning with IEC international standards to promote interoperability and quality assurance.

Deployment Requirements The Tanzania Communications Regulatory Authority (TCRA) governs the deployment of fiber optic cables under the 2026 rules. Key requirements include:

- Deployment permits:** Operators must obtain approval before installation.
- Cable installation:** Guidelines cover direct burial, ducted, and aerial deployment, including spacing for handholes (2 km for direct buried, 500 m for ducted) and manholes (4 km).
- Splicing and connectors:** Standards for splicing, pigtails, and connector types ensure minimal signal loss and network reliability.
- Infrastructure sharing:** Rules encourage sharing of poles or ducts to optimize resources and reduce environmental impact.
- Local Manufacturing** Tanzania has local manufacturers such as RaddyFiber Manufacturing Ltd, producing high-quality fiber optic cables and accessories, including:
 - Outdoor cables (armored single or double jacket)
 - Patch cord connectors and other connection accessories
