- Aerial Installations:** For pole-mounted cables, ensure All-Dielectric Self-Supporting (ADSS) cables are used near power lines, and follow safe climbing and lifting procedures. Workers must use personal protective equipment including hard hats, gloves, steel-toed boots, and maintain a 3-point contact when climbing ladders or poles.
- Underground Installations:** Ensure ducts are clear, and avoid damage from excavation or flooding. PE jackets with UV protection are recommended for aerial exposure.
- Pole and Anchor Requirements** When relocating cables on utility poles: Verify minimum separation between drilled holes and existing anchors. Do not attach guying or auxiliary eye attachments to existing anchors with...
