Overview

The following guidelines should be observed when grounding a cabinet: An unpainted earth reference plane or rail must be installed on the floor of the cabinet for the conventional reference potential. The cabinet was “grounded” to the system neutral—but not properly “earthed” to the soil electrode system. The practical takeaway: Industrial electrical cabinets require BOTH proper grounding (for signal reference and circuit operation) AND earthing (for safety and fault protection). Confusing these.
