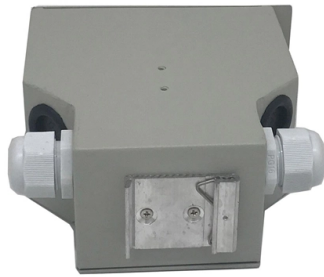


Three-level distribution box main distribution diagram

A three-level distribution system consists of a main distribution box, secondary distribution boxes, and tertiary distribution boxes, each progressively distributing and protecting electrical power to end-use equipment.

Overview of the Three Levels

First-Level Distribution Box (Main Distribution Box) Acts as the primary hub for power distribution, usually installed near the power source or transformer. Receives incoming electrical energy and distributes it to secondary distribution boxes. Key components include main circuit breakers, main leakage protectors, voltmeters, ammeters, and isolating switches for centralized monitoring and control. Provides overall protection and centralized management of the construction site or facility power system.

Second-Level Distribution Box (Secondary Distribution Box) Installed in specific areas or near large electrical equipment. Receives power from the main distribution box and distributes it to tertiary distribution boxes. Contains branch circuit breakers and branch leakage protectors to protect individual circuits. Often designed with dual doors, durable coatings, and rainproof tops for safety and outdoor use.

Third-Level Distribution Box (Tertiary Distribution Box / Switch Box) Located at the end of the distribution chain, directly supplying power to individual equipment or groups of similar devices. Equipped with isolation switches, circuit breakers, and leakage protectors for direct control and protection. Follows the principle of “one device, one switch, one leakage, one box”, ensuring independent protection for each electrical appliance.

Wiring and Protection Principles

Two-level protection: Leakage protection is installed at both the main and tertiary levels to enhance safety. Busbars are used in three-phase systems to connect main and branch circuit breakers efficiently, ensuring balanced load distribution and preventing overloading. Each level is designed...
