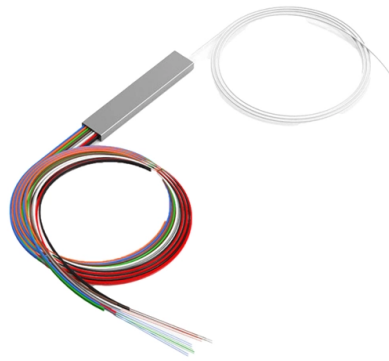


Tools for making fiberglass cable trays
