

Unloading galvanized cable trays

Inspect for Damage: Check for scratches, cuts, or dents immediately after unloading. Minor scratches may form a protective zinc patina over time, but deep damage should be repaired according to manufacturer recommendations.

Avoid Abrasive Contact: Do not place trays against rough surfaces or metal objects that can remove the zinc coating.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): Use gloves to protect hands from sharp edges and safety shoes to prevent injury from falling trays.

Team Lifting: For long or heavy trays, use team lifting to reduce the risk of injury and prevent tray deformation.
