For environments with moisture or corrosive conditions, consider fiberglass-reinforced plastic (FRP) trays for non-conductive, corrosion-resistant support. Mounting and Support Secure the tray to the shaft walls using brackets or clamps rated for vertical loads. Support spacing should follow NEC guidelines, typically 1.5 to 3 meters (5–10 feet) depending on tray type and cable weight. For vertical runs, fasten cables to the tray rungs or transverse members to prevent sagging and maintain spacing. Ensure at least 12 inches of vertical clearance above the tray for installation and maintenance access, as required by the 2026 NEC update. Cable Installation and Management Use Tray Rated (Type TC) or Metal-Clad (Type MC) cables suitable for open-air tray environments. Maintain separation between high-power and low-voltage cables to prevent electromagnetic interference (EMI). Do not exceed fill limits: 50% for control/low-voltage cables. Use listed cable ties approved for tray applications; avoid standard plastic ties that may fail in plenum or high-temperature conditions. At transition points, provide strain relief to protect terminations and avoid overtightening ties to prevent cable jacket damage.
