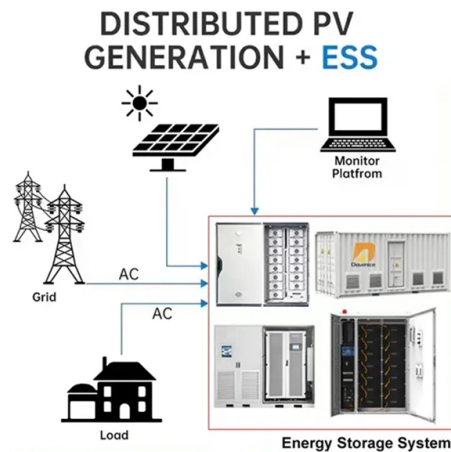


Vietnam Seizes Fiber Optic Cable

The U.S. has reportedly lobbied Vietnam to avoid contracts with Chinese companies, citing potential risks of sabotage or espionage . This is part of a broader digital infrastructure development strategy, which includes rolling out 5G networks and integrating technologies like AI, cloud computing, and IoT by 2030 . Vietnam plans to expand its undersea cable network to 10 cables by 2030, though this remains modest compared to regional neighbors such as Singapore, Malaysia, and the Philippines . Implications of Cable Control Control over undersea cables is critical for internet reliability, national security, and economic competitiveness. The ADC not only increases Vietnam's international connectivity and internet speeds but also provides redundancy to mitigate disruptions from cable failures . Any action to seize or secure cables would likely be motivated by the need to protect national digital infrastructure and ensure uninterrupted service for both civilian and military communications.
