Types of Optical Cables Optical cables, also known as fiber optic cables, transmit data using light signals through glass or plastic fibers. They are primarily classified into: Single-mode fibers (SMF): Designed for long-distance transmission with minimal signal loss, typically used in backbone networks and international links. ITU-T G.652 is the global baseline standard for single-mode fibers, optimized for 1310 nm operation with low attenuation, while G.655 fibers are non-zero dispersion-shifted for high-capacity DWDM systems. Multimode fibers (MMF): Support shorter distances and multiple light modes, commonly used in enterprise networks and data centers. They are categorized as OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, and OM5, each with different bandwidth and distance capabilities. Fiber cables can be made from pure or doped silica or plastic, with varying core, cladding, and coating diameters to meet mechanical and environmental requirements. International Standards Optical cables adhere to rigorous international standards to ensure interoperability, reliability, and performance: ITU-T Recommendations (G.652, G.655, G.657, etc.) define fiber characteristics and performance. IEC 60793 and IEC 60794 cover fiber and cable specifications. TIA-568.3-D and ISO/IEC 11801 provide structured cabling standards for telecommunications. Telcordia GR-20 addresses mechanical and environmental performance for telecom-grade cables.
