5. Optical Coatings and Wedges Some beam splitters include anti-reflective (AR) coatings or wedged plates to reduce ghosting and improve transmission efficiency . These are often integral to the beam splitter but can be considered part of accessory options for optimizing performance.
6. Mounting and Alignment Accessories Additional accessories include mounts, holders, and adapters that secure the beam splitter in the optical path at precise angles, typically 45° , and allow fine alignment for interferometry or microscopy app...
