Visual Fault Locator (VFL) VFLs use a visible red laser to identify breaks, cracks, or tight bends in the fiber. This tool is particularly useful for quick continuity checks and locating physical damage.

Light Source and Power Meter (LSPM) This combination is used for end-to-end insertion loss testing, ensuring that the installed fiber plant is within the allowable loss budget. It is a standard requirement in international testing standards.

Additional Features

Polarity and Continuity Testing: Ensures correct fiber connections and signal flow direction.

Wavelength Testing: Single-mode fibers are typically tested at 1310 nm and 1550 nm, while multimode fibers are tested at 850 nm and 1300 nm.

Data Logging and Documentation: Modern testers often include memory or software to record test results for compliance and quality assurance.
