- Wire Gauge:** Select cross-sectional area according to load current requirements to prevent overheating.
- Insulation and Protection:** Ensure proper insulation, avoid exposed copper, and use cables rated for environmental conditions (heat, moisture, oil, or mechanical stress).
- Cable Management:** Maintain neat wiring, secure cables, and label all circuits for easy identification and maintenance.
- Grounding and Safety**
- Grounding:** Metal enclosures, electrical boards, and appliance casings must be grounded. Connect protective neutral wires reliably through terminal boards.
- Protective Devices:** Install circuit breakers, fuses, and leakage protectors. Each branch circuit should have its own protection to prevent overloads and short circuits.
- Breaker Configurations:** Single-pole breakers disconnect only the live conductor, while two-pole breakers disconnect both line and neutral fo...
