- Multicast and Broadcast Control:** Aggregation switches manage broadcast and multicast traffic, preventing unnecessary flooding across the network and improving overall performance.
- IP Address Translation and Network Segmentation:** They can perform NAT or other IP translation functions and support VLAN tagging to isolate traffic, enhancing security and network organization.
