- BiDi SFP (Bidirectional Single-Fiber):** Uses a single fiber with two wavelengths (A/B pairing) to transmit and receive simultaneously, saving fiber in constrained environments.

Wavelength and Speed Matching: Ensure both ends of the link use the same wavelength (e.g., 1310 nm or 1550 nm) and support the same data rate (1G, 10G, etc.).
