

What to do if optical fiber cables need to be run through iron pipes

Pull the cable smoothly and continuously, never exceeding the manufacturer's specified maximum tension, typically around 600 pounds for outdoor cables. For very long runs, consider pulling from the middle outwards or using mid-span access points to manage tension and re-lubricate.

Safety and Planning Plan the route carefully, considering accessibility, future expansion, and avoiding electromagnetic interference. Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) and follow safety guidelines during installation. Leave service loops at both ends to facilitate future maintenance or splicing. Mark the cable clearly as fiber optic to prevent accidental damage during later work.
