

What to do if the fiber optic connector comes loose

Re-terminate the Connector If reseating does not fix the issue, the connector may need to be re-terminated. Steps include:

- Strip back the outer jacket and buffer to expose the fiber strand.
- Cleave the fiber to the correct length using a precision cleaver.
- Insert the fiber into a new connector and secure the locking tab or crimp as per the connector instructions.
- Test the connection with a visual fault locator or fiber optic meter to ensure proper seating and low insertion loss.

Preventive Measures

- Avoid bending the fiber beyond its minimum bend radius to prevent microbends or macrobends that can loosen connectors.
- Use dust caps when connectors are not in use to prevent contamination.
- Regularly inspect and clean connectors as part of routine maintenance.
- Ensure proper strain relief and secure routing to prevent accidental tugging or movement that can loosen connectors.
