

What type of installation is it to run fiber optic cables on the roof

For long roof runs, consider supporting the cable with Aramid yarn-reinforced conduits to reduce stress and protect against environmental damage.

Safety and Maintenance Wear protective gear such as gloves and safety glasses when handling fiber optic cables. Avoid stepping on cables or placing heavy objects on them. Inspect the installation periodically for loose fasteners, water ingress, or ph...
