- For Arduino or small modules,** the sensor should face the area where light measurement is most critical, such as near a window or above a workspace.
- Consider Sensor Type:**
 - Photocells or LDRs:** Best for general ambient light detection; place where light exposure is representative of the environment.
 - Daylight sensors:** Use closed-loop placement in small rooms or open-loop near windows to anticipate daylight contribution.
 - Integrated luminaire sensors:** Each fixture senses locally; ensure uniformity and avoid over-dimming at room edges.
- Test Before Finalizing:** Experiment with different positions to ensure the sensor responds accurately to changes in light levels. Adjust placement to avoid false triggers or under-detection.

- Connect the sensor to an analog input pin (e.g., A0 on Arduino Uno) to read light intensity values.
