

Where should the electrical control box for escalators be placed

The control box should not interfere with required working clearances or emergency access.

Environmental Considerations: The control box should be protected from water, dust, and mechanical damage. It should be positioned so that it is not exposed to moving parts, and any doors or covers must either open at least 90 degrees or be removable for safe maintenance.

Operational Visibility: While the control box does not need to be in the line of sight of passengers, it should be within sight or easily reachable by maintenance staff to allow safe operation and emergency shutdown if necessary.
