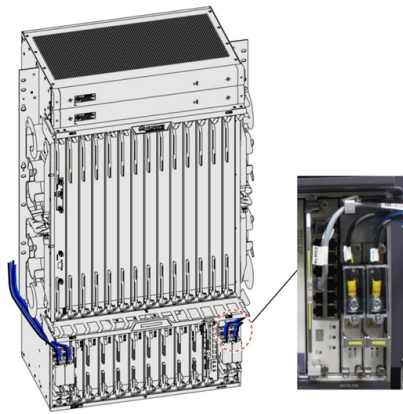


Where to plug in the optical module
