- Earth Link:** Connect the earth wire from the supply and all load circuits to the earth bus bar to ensure safety against faults.

Wiring Order and Color Coding

- Arrange MCBs from left to right, with the main MCB on the left and branch MCBs to the right.
- Standard wire colors: Phase wires – red, yellow, or green; Neutral wire – blue; Earth wire – green/yellow.
- Route wires neatly: incoming supply on the left, outgoing circuits on the right, and bind wires with plastic ties for organization.

Wire Sizing

- Lighting and socket circuits: typically 2.5mm² wires.
- Air conditioning or high-power circuits: 2.5mm² to 4.0mm² wires depending on load.
- Ensure wire ratings match the MCB capacity to prevent overloads.

Safety Precautions

- Always turn off the main power supply before wiring.
- Verify connections with a multimeter before switch...
