

Which of the 70-core optical fiber cables has 4 cores



Overview

Unveiled at the 2026 Optical Fiber Communication Conference, our 4-core multicore fiber increases network capacity by packing multiple independent data paths into a single strand of optical fiber — without increasing the outer diameter of the fiber. For example, the total number of cores in an MTP®-8 trunk cable equals 4 (number of branches) x 8 (MTP-8). Experience: In the wiring room (horizontal wiring cabinet) of each floor, there is one optical fiber, generally six cores: two cores are used, two cores are reserved, and two cores are redundant; there are also eight-core optical fibers. The specification's minimum configuration is 2 cores per 48.
