

# Which port to plug the fiber optic cable into the router

Access the router's admin panel via a web browser (commonly 192.168.1.1 or 192.168.0.1) to enter any ISP credentials if required and configure settings.

**Key Notes** Do not plug the fiber cable directly into a standard router unless it has a dedicated SFP or fiber port designed for direct fiber input. Ensure the ONT and router are placed near power outlets and in a dry, ventilated area. Use the correct fiber connector type (SC/APC, SC/UPC, LC, etc.) as specified by your ISP. Following this sequence ensures your fiber optic internet connection is properly established and maximizes speed and stability.
