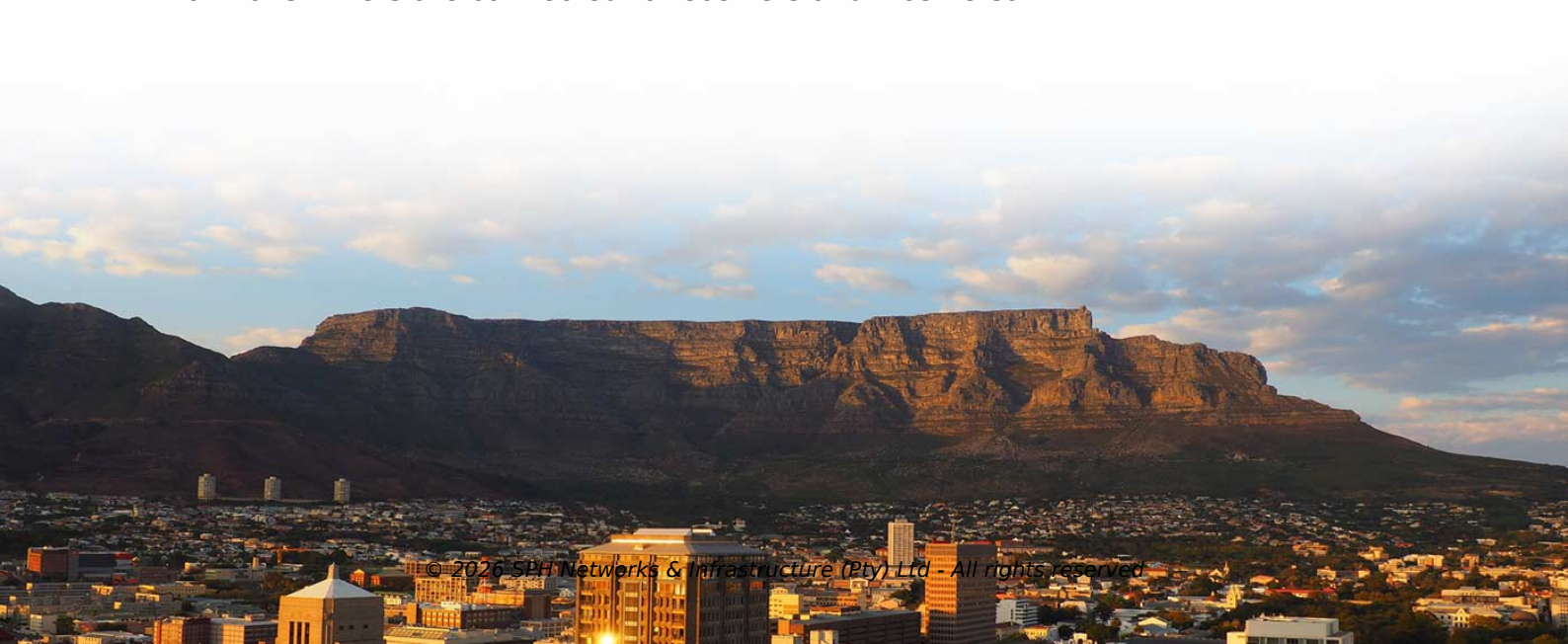


Why do fiber optic cables for switches need to be inserted backwards



Overview

When connecting terminated duplex fiber optic cable between two network switches, ensure the connections are reversed between the SFP transceiver ports (connection A to B and B to A). SFP transceiver modules rely on the transmission of separate send and receive signals. Flipping both ends puts you right back where you started. In 2025, connecting two switches with 1G/10G/25G/100G (SR/LR) fiber is still stupidly simple: Buy any normal duplex LC-LC patch cable → plug it in → if no link, flip one end 180° → done. Use the right adapters To maintain mate-ability of connectors that are APC (angled-polish), you must use Type B (aligned keys with a.
