Configure your router via its admin panel, entering ISP credentials if required, and update firmware for optimal performance. Routers compatible with fiber often have SFP or WAN ports labeled for fiber and support high-speed standards like Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 7 for multi-gigabit connections.
