

Wiring of surface-mounted indoor distribution box

Grounding and Protection Connect the grounding wire to the designated busbar or terminal to ensure safety. Each circuit should have its own protective device, such as a breaker or fuse, and consider surge protection if needed. For areas prone to moisture, use GFCI outlets where required.

Surface Wiring Connections Surface-mounted boxes allow wiring without cutting into walls. Use PVC trunking, moulding, or conduit to route wires from the box to outlets, switches, or other devices. Secure the trunking every 5 feet or as recommended, and use elbows, couplings, and junction boxes to maintain neat and safe routing. Label wires for easier troubleshooting and future maintenance.
